### About The Programme



Climate Skills programme builds on HSBC and British Council's long history of collaboration and co-creation of programmes at country and regional level to now build a global approach to youth skills development.



The programme will provide the skills marginalised young people Brazil, Mexico, India, Indonesia, and Viet Nam need to be resilient to the impacts of climate change and to participate effectively in the transition from fossil fuel to sustainable energy sources.



### Outcomes

Marginalised young people are able to access opportunity in green economy and just transition.



Local community organisations are better equipped to engage marginalised young people in climate literacy and skills training.



Ecosystem (government, local employer, community organisations, education, and training providers) to support skills development for young people and support a just transition is formed.



Global connection of youth and local community organisations to share knowledge, and to inspire change.

Climate Action grants for young people to lead climate social action projects in their own communities.
